**PLEASE PLAN ON COMING TO ONE OF THE OPEN HOUSES TO GET FITTED FOR SHOES BEFORE YOUR FIRST LESSON.**

It will really help our first class go more smoothly if you are prepared with the proper dancewear BEFORE classes begin. IF you can't make one of these Open Houses, call and arrange a time you can come in to look at shoes so you will be prepared for the FIRST lesson. It is unfair to your child, and the rest of the class, to wait until the first class to think about new shoes for the fall.

We will have a supply of NEW shoes available at the Open Houses.

We can have your size available if you will call and let us know what size you need.

Used shoes will be available at all the Open Houses..

.. You can drop off your used shoes to sell at any time. It is advisable to drop them off BEFORE the Open Houses. I'D really LOVE IT if people would drop off their used shoes before the Open Houses. Then we will have a decent supply when people come in to be fitted. If you drop off your shoes at your first lesson, when most people are already set, they sit there all year long.

You may drop off shoes and leave them by the inside front door if no one is there. Just be sure your name is in them....

New beginner classes, kindergarten and newly formed jazz or ballet classes will begin the week of September 13th or later.

## TUITION INFORMATION

We will NOT raise our tuition rates this year.

Tuition for this year's classes will be as follows:

### **BASIC COMBO CLASS**

\$95 for an 8-week term ( or \$12 per individual

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\$15 registration fee per family

3rd member of family is 1/2 price

Individual Combo class....\$12 per class if paid separately.

**Total first payment - \$110**

Extra jazz, pointe or ballet classes will be:

1st extra class per week.. \$64. per term(8.00)

2nd extra class per week ..\$56 per term (7.00)

3rd or 4th " " \$48

There will be a \$10 late fee charge on all tuition payments not paid by the third week that it becomes due.

## SCHEDULE FOR FALL

I have been working on the fall schedule based on the form you turned in at recital time . It is complete except for some of the extra classes & beginners. Even if you did send in a form before, you will **not be** officially registered until we receive your registration, release, and tuition check for fall term.

And Get Those Notebooks in to me so they can be corrected before classes start. No teachers will be scheduled for fall without corrected notebooks.

## WHAT TO WEAR TO CLASS

Our Basic class outfit for students Lev II and up is  
**BLACK LEOTARD**  
**PINK TIGHTS**  
**PINK BALLET SHOES**  
**BLACK TAP SHOES \***

Under 8 yrs. old students may wear any color leotard and tights as long as it is plain.

**BALLET SHOES**...Pink for all except boys

Please do not fit ballet shoes too big.

**JAZZ SHOES:** BLACK for beginners and TAN for everyone else...Black shoes can still be worn for classes, but by recital time, we will need tan ones. Jazz students may wear Black Jazz pants (no baggy knees)and colored leotards. No shorts or skirts.

**TAP:** Advanced students who wear high-heeled tap shoes wear TAN . Everyone else wears BLACK Graduated heel tap shoes are the kind where the heels are slightly higher than the beginner flat kind. And the taps are secured with screws instead of nails. The heel gets higher as the shoe gets larger in size.These are recommended for Level III - VI

All dancewear must be PLAIN solid-color.

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**NO . . . REPEAT... NO..... PATTERNED LEOTARDS OR BLOUSY LEOTARDS OR RUFFLED LEOTARDS OR SKIRTED LEOTARDS OR RUFFLED SLEEVES**

All girls hair must be tied back away from the face and preferably off the neck. NO T-shirts, tank tops or sweat clothes are allowed in class.

And **NO SCRUNCHIES.**

All girls who need to wear a bra **MUST** wear a bra with leotards.

**Note....THERE IS NO DRESS CODE FOR ADULT CLASSES OR SKIPPERS....**

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If your class is changing colors you may wear your old shoes until they no longer fit.  
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**REMEMBER....**New shoes will be available at Open House.As well as leotards and tights.

Please try to bring in your old shoes for selling **BEFORE** the Open Houses if you can. That way, more people will have a chance at them.

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It is **STRONGLY** encouraged for the students to add extra ballet to their dance studies from Level IV on.  
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Remember.....get this form returned to us as soon as possible. Why not do it right now.?

## BEGINNERS

If you have friends who would like to start at Barbi Lee, please have them call for a "Beginners" newsletter, and let them know about our Open Houses. We will be starting new beginner classes in all age levels. Older beginners will be placed with students their own age. I would particularly like some boys this year.

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## CLASS LISTINGS

COMBO CLASS #1.....\$95/8wks

1 hour class, once a week consisting of ballet, tap & tumbling..Ages 4 & up..... Some jazz included from 2nd grade on up.

BALLET.....\$64/8wks\*

1 hour technique class... Once a week.

Ages 9 and up. Includes pointe work for those aged 12 and up who qualify. MUST be used as a 2nd class.

JAZZ.....\$64/8wks\*

1 hour technique class. Once a week.

Ages 9 and up.This class only available to students who are also enrolled in a Combo. class.

HIP HOP.....\$56/ 8 WKS\*

Our newest, hippest kind of dance. Sometimes called "Street Dance". We are lucky enough to have . Ramicah Witz to teach this inspiring new style. Only available as a 3rd class. Age 10 and up please.

BOYS TAP & JAZZ.....\$95/8 wks

1 hour class, once a week consisting of basics of jazz and tap, with stretching, leaping, rhythm, noise, what more could a guy want?

ADULT COMBO.....\$95/ 8 wks

1 hour class, once a week consisting of basic conditioning moves of ballet & jazz plus the great rhythm of tap. Come on moms & dads...join the fun. (You don't have to wear a leotard!!!)

## ADAPTIVE DANCE

### **PARENT PARTICIPATION**

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you parents for your splendid co-operation and participation this past year. You know that our style of teaching works better when there is a parent there for each child. Parents who do come should take notes or record the lesson and oversee practice times. As the students of Jr. High age move into that next level where they don't require your everyday attendance, please keep in mind that they still need to be cared about, fussed over and brought to task now and then, so please watch occasionally. Please help them follow thru on practicing and bringing their tape players along to classes.

### **WHY WE STUDY WHAT WE STUDY . . .**

Classes at Barbi Lee are a combination of ballet, tap, jazz & acrobatics. **BALLET** is the foundation of all dance and so is especially necessary to the beginning student. **TAP** dance will teach rhythm and fast movement and fast thinking to help the dancer in moving quickly and in memorization of steps. **JAZZ** dance, because of the fun music, strikes at the soul of the dancer and frees the body to move more naturally. The amount of **ACROBATICS** we teach isn't excessive, just enough to keep the body limber.

Through the years we have discovered that the best dancer is a well-rounded dancer and the way to get the most out of your dance education is to be exposed to a forms of dance. The teacher who accepts students in Jazz alone is not doing the student any favor. Though it may well be the most fun form for the student, it is kind of like eating dessert all day. Nowhere are you getting the nutrition! — the real technique that a dancer needs!

Students at Barbi Lee study all forms of dance in the same lesson, sharing the time equally between ballet and tap and jazz. We have a recital at the end of the year in which the beginning through 3rd year students perform one dance in one of two performances. Students who have studied 4 years and up dance in both performances. When the student gets into Jr. High (if in an advanced level class by that time) she/he will perform 2 dances. Occasionally, if the student takes a lot of extra classes, they will do more than 2 dances in the show. Students performing many dances in the show have earned that right.

### **NEW TEACHER TRAINING....**

If you are at least an 8th grader, and in Level 8 or above, you may be interested in taking the teacher training workshop offered this summer. If you are wanting to do this, call me right away and I will send you the proper info. We will be meeting Aug.23-26 during the day....AND one day fo the next weekend.

### **ATTENDANCE RULE**

No student may perform in the recital who has missed more than 8 classes during the year.Please keep this in mind when registering for the year. Dance does require some commitment on your part.

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
